



Terms and conditions: 5x spots on Island of Ireland Famil 2026 – September 2026

This prize is sponsored by Tourism Ireland.

To be in with a chance to win, participants must sign up (first name, last name, travel agency/consortia and a valid email address) and complete five courses of the Ireland Specialist Programme. Participants must also correctly complete the respective quiz at the end of the course to be in the draw to win a spot on the Tourism Ireland famil 2026.

Each of the five (5) prizes include:

- One (1) place on the Tourism Ireland famil taking place from **September 25 – October 3, 2026**
- All accommodation, activities, and ground arrangements as outlined in the official famil itinerary (to be provided to selected winners before departure)

Return flights (Economy tickets) to Ireland will be organised and covered by Tourism Ireland for each winner, departing from the winners nearest major Australian or New Zealand gateway.

Any incidental or personal expenses are the responsibility of the winner.

The prize is non-transferable, cannot be exchanged for money, and has no cash value.

This competition is open to residents of Australia and New Zealand.

Participants should be older than 21 years at the time of competition entry, in order to be eligible to participate.

Participants must be active travel advisors registered within the AU or NZ travel industry.

Participants are not required to make a purchase in order to participate.

Internet access is required in order to participate.

This competition is open from April 16th, 2026 – May 31st, 2026.

A total of five (5) winners will be chosen from the pool of agents who completed all five chapters of the Ireland Specialist Programme and correctly answered all quiz questions during this period. Four (4) winners will be drawn from Australia and one (1) winner from New Zealand.

The winner will be notified by email by 5pm on June 4th, 2026 and will have three business days to react and accept their prize. If the winner does not reply within those dates, the prize will be passed on to the next winner.

Once ticketed, any changes made will be charged the current applicable fees.



Any upgrades or alterations may be made and will be the responsibility of prize winner.

Prize-winner is responsible for the cost of transportation to direct Ireland flight gateway in Australia and New Zealand.

Prize-winner must hold a valid passport with at least six months' validity from the date of travel.

Prize-winner is responsible for ensuring they meet all entry, visa, and health requirements for Ireland and any transit points.

Prize-winner must travel on the dates provided by Tourism Ireland.

Tourism Ireland will liaise with the winner to organize and book the flights in the name of the winner.

Any future increase to government taxes shall be the responsibility of the prize winner.

By entering, entrants agree that the information they provide may be used by Tourism Ireland for the administration of this drawing and may also be used to carry outreach about this competition, however, Tourism Ireland will only contact entrants with further promotions if they have opted in to receive them.
